

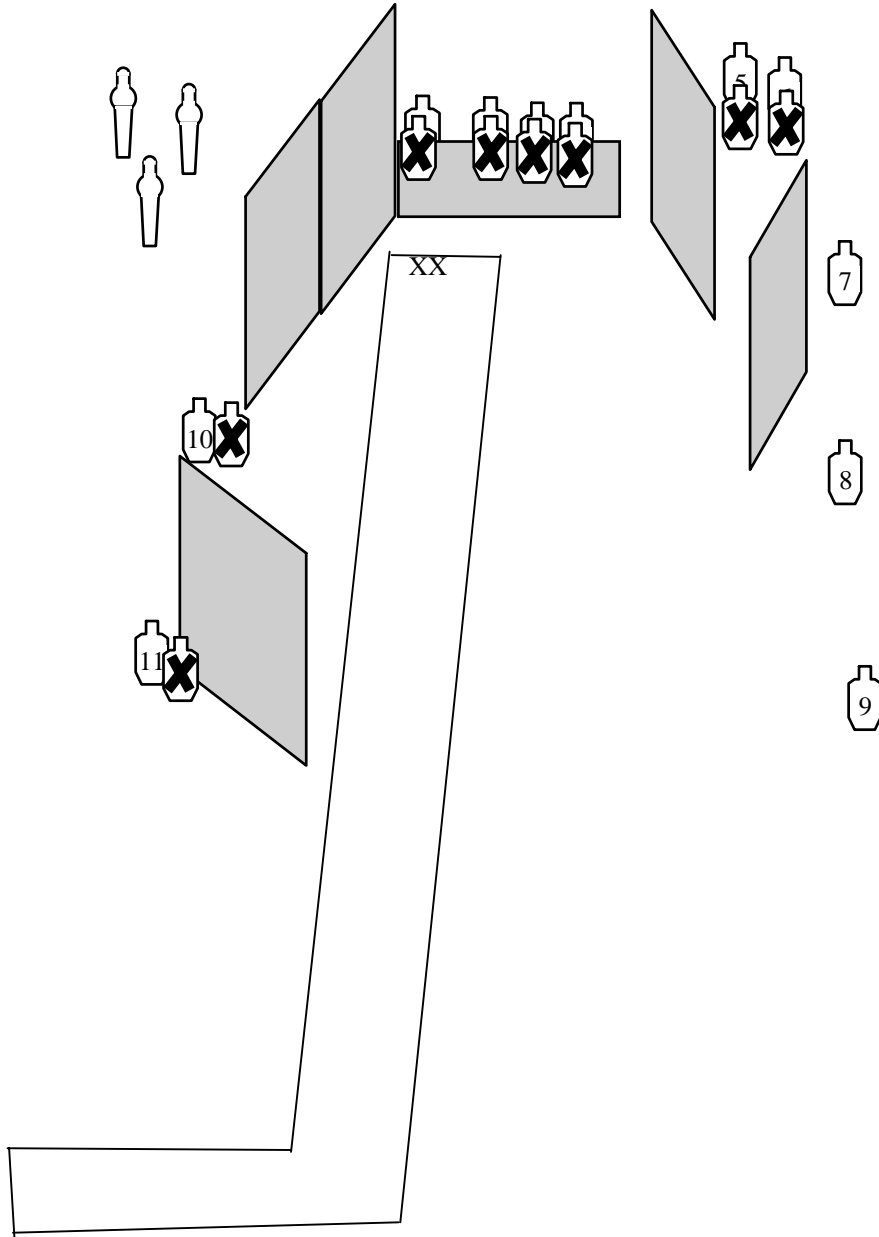


OBRPC September '06 USPSA Match Stage 2 - Back-Up

START POSITION: Standing with hands naturally at sides, toes touching X's	
GUN READY CONDITION: Loaded and holstered per current USPSA rules	SCORING: Comstock, 25 rounds, 125 points
STAGE PROCEDURE: On signal, engage all targets as they become visible from within the FFZ.	TARGETS: 11 IPSC, 2 PP, 1 USP
	SCORED HITS: Best 2 per paper, KD steel = 1A
	START-STOP: Audible - Last shot
	RULES: USPSA current edition



Set-Up notes: Set T- 1to T-6 with the top non scoring border of the No-Shoot aligned with the C/B perf. Set T-1 to T-4 so that they are visible only for the first few steps back from the low wall. Use angle stands. T-5 & T-6 should be visible only after the shooter has retreated about half way up the range. Steel is only visible from furthest uprange position. T-10 & T-11 are visible from opposite sides of the furthest uprange wall, T-7, 8 & 9 are visible pretty ugly much from halfway back through almost the middle end of the thingie.
