Course Designer: Matt de Vries



START POSITION: Hands at sides, feet on Xs.

GUN READY CONDITION: Gun loaded in Holster.

SCORING: Comstock, 22 rounds, 110 points

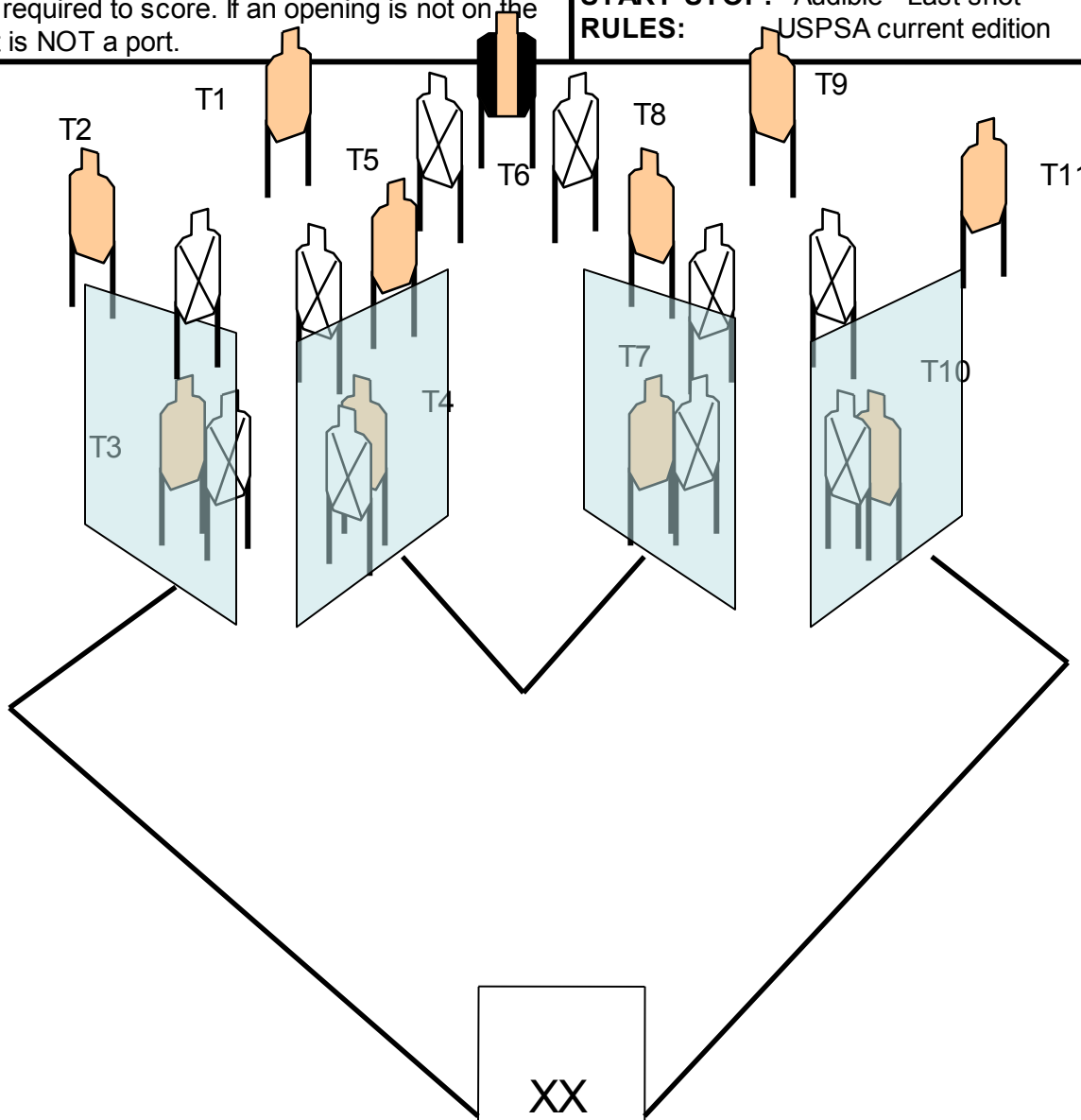
TARGETS: 11 paper

STAGE PROCEDURE: Upon start signal, engage targets as required to score. If an opening is not on the diagram, it is NOT a port.

SCORED HITS: Best 2 per paper, KD steel = 1A

START-STOP: Audible - Last shot

RULES: USPSA current edition



Setup notes: T2 and T11 should only be visible from the ends of the free fire zone by the walls. Be careful to avoid shoot throughs. Fault lines at the edge of the V by the walls should have the outside corners no more than a step past the openings for the Vs formed by the walls. This is to prevent RO traps at either end of the course of fire. Targets MUST be staked to prevent causing technical issues while scoring and pasting.
